2020

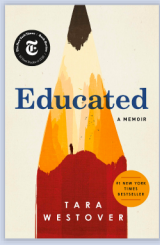

SUSTAINABLE SHELVES

Late this year the library began participating in the Sustainable Shelves program with Baker & Taylor, our major book supplier. The program is a simple, environmentally sustainable, flexible process by which the library obtains credit for weeded books suitable for resale. Weeded books not suitable for resale are then responsibly recycled through this program. This "win-win" program generates additional funds for the library while maintaining a vibrant, viable circulating collection.
